Rising Junior Course Registration: March 17-20

- To prepare for registration, an assembly will be held on March 2 during homeroom. From March 2 to 13, you will meet with a counselor or administrator to discuss your course options. During that time, consult with your parents and teachers about your program of studies for next year.
- Course descriptions are listed in the course catalog. The course catalog is available online through the St. John's website and through Self-Service on your iPad. Make sure you read each description carefully.

All juniors must take 6.5 credits. All honors and Advanced Placement classes require faculty approval.

- **Before registering for an honors or AP class please review the prerequisites listed in the course catalog.****
The department faculty will review all course requests and submit a list of names receiving approval.

Requirements:

- **Religion:** All juniors must take Morality and Social Justice.
- **English:** All juniors must take British Literature, Honors British Literature, or AP English Language and Composition.
- **Mathematics:** All students must have four years of math, including Geometry and Algebra II.
- **Science:** All students must have three years of a laboratory science.
- **Social Studies:** All students must have three years of social studies, including Geography, World History/Geography 2 (or AP World History), and US History (or AP US History).
- **Modern or Classical Language:** All students must have two years of a modern or classical language. De La Salle Scholars must have three years of a language.

How Do I Register?

1. Go to <http://powerschool.stjohns-chs.org>
2. Type in your username and password
3. On the left side of the page, click on the icon labeled "Class Registration"
4. For each subject, select a course from the pull-down menu.
 - Religion
 - English
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - Social Studies
 - Modern or Classical Language
 - Full-Credit Electives
 - Half-Credit Electives
5. Once you have selected all of your credits please hit the submit button. You need to be made to your course requests.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT YOU MUST REGISTER FOR AT LEAST 6.5 CREDITS!

- Please make sure you have chosen classes that fulfill your graduation requirements if you have questions about these requirements.
- If you are planning to play a sport in college, please make sure you meet the requirements.
- At the end of the third and fourth quarters, both departments, as we review Honors and AP course requests. Please note that approval granted is revoked if students do not maintain their performance during the following year.

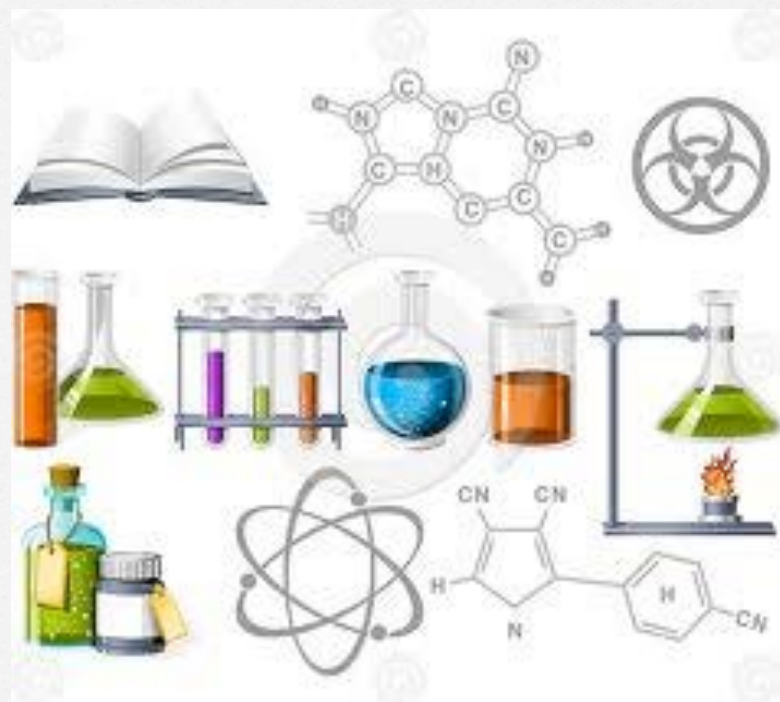
